### DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This is a 2-1/2 story, three bay wide and two bay deep house with an "A" frame roof of metal and steep pitch. There are chimneys enclosed in either gable. The west wall adjoins the next house. A four bay long and two bay wide wing along the west wall have a very steep shed roof matching that of the next building and gives the appearance of a steep "A" frame even though separate. All roofing is metal. A 1-1/2 story wing is built onto the rear. All brickwork is common bond. A paneled door occupies the east front bay, has a four pane overlight, wood lintel, and a louvered outer door. All front windows are 6/6 sash have wood lintels and sills and louvered shutters. Side and rear windows are mostly 6/6 with wood lintels and sills. A balcony extends along the east side of the wing. An attractive cast iron railing is on either side of the one step porch. A two string brick cornice fronts the roofline. The house has a very low foundation and a herringbone brick pavement.
