**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

This is a small 2-1/2 story home detached on the east side. It is three bays wide, two bays deep and has a ~~two~~ bay square "L" shaped wing. The front section has a rather steep metal "A" frame roof while the wing has a metal shed roof. The gables contain enclosed simple brick chimneys. All brickwork is painted common bond. A six panel door with overlight and wooden lintel occupies the east bay. All second floor windows are 6/6 sash while the first floor windows have 2/2 sash, all with wood lintels and sills and louvered shutters. A three string brick cornice extends along the front roofline. A balcony runs along the east side of the wing. A low fieldstone foundation is faced with concrete.
