DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

#231 is now a three story brick house detached on the left (S) side, is three bays wide and three longer bays in depth, with a two story brick "L" shaped wing four bays deep and two bays wide with enclosed side galleries and newer third story and rear frame extensions. According to front and side wall evidence, this was built as a 2-1/2 story house and all brickwork is in common bond. The front entrance-way occupies the right bay with a newer glass door, three step granite porch, large transom, and moulded transom bar. This is framed by plain pilasters with fluted and moulded brackets supporting an overhanging moulded cornice. This leads to a wide vestibule with paneled wainscoating and a three-part inner doorway with sidelights and overlights and with a long dentiled transom bar. Front windows are now of 1/1 sash with louvered shutters and moulded top wood lintels with projecting end blocks angled down to a square base. The exposed side of the front section has 2/2 sash windows and the wing has various newer windows. To the left of the house is a newer classic styled veranda with Ionic pillars and pilasters, topped by a ballustrade. The front section roof now slopes to the rear with a wide enclosed chimney centered in the left sidewall. The wing has a metal shed roof. The front roofline is decorated by an ornate Victorian cornice with bands of incised designs, pointed dentils, quatre-foils, and the bays are divided by fluted moulded brackets. This house rests on a low fieldstone foundation. It is fronted by a herringbone patterned brick pavement. There is an attractive side yard with shrubs and seasonal flowers.
