DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

#111 is a three story, brick apartment house, detached on the left (W) side. It is four bays wide and three long bays in depth with rear balconies, a three story, two bay long, one bay wide, "L" shaped wing, and a one bay square frame extension. All brickwork is of common bond. The front entrance-way occupies the right bay with a door of small panes, leaded glass transom in a geometric design, and a worn marble sill. This is framed by a classic enclosure of Doric pilasters topped by a full pediment with dentil trim. All front and side windows are of 6/1 sash with some side windows being double and some rear windows are of 2/2 sash. All are headed by two row brick segmental arches and most have louvered shutters. All roofing is of low slope. The front Victorian cornice line protrudes with small, closely-spaced fluted and moulded brackets and supported by long decorated brackets dividing the bays. In between are wood panels incised with crosses and scrolls. This building sets on a rather low foundation. This is a large lawn area with flower beds to the rear.
