### DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This is a pair of 2-1/2 story brick detached houses, four bays wide, approximately three bays in depth with a 2-1/2 story brick "T" shaped wing two bays in depth and three bays wide with a side balcony remaining on #40. All brickwork is in common bond and recently restored to display a salmon colored brick. Front entranceways formerly occupied the end bays, but #38 has been altered to the second bay from the right with both now having newer doors and segmental arched transoms. All front windows are now of 1/1 sash with protruding brick segmental arches as over the doors. First floor windows are protected by cast iron boxed grills. Rear windows are all 6/6 sash with wood lintels and sills. The attics are lighted by two six pane windows on each side gable and on the rear gable. Both roofs are of moderate slope "A" frames and of metal. Double flue enclosed chimneys rise from the side gables. The front roofline rests on a two string brick cornice. The building sets on a low fieldstone foundation.
