## DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This is a 2-1/2 story, detached brick pair of houses, approximately four bays square with a 1-1/2 story brick "T" shaped wing, two bays in depth and approximately three bays wide. All brickwork is in common bond. Simple front entranceways occupy the end bays with newer glass over panel doors, paneled enframements and #222 retains a three pane overlight. The front windows of #220 are of 6/6 sash with wood lintels decorated by top mouldings with small raised moulded end block-brackets as over the doorway. #222 retains the 6/6 sash window with the decorated lintels on the second story only with the first floor having 1/1 sash windows and plain lintels and sills. The wing windows are low "lie on your stomach" style pairs of four pane casements with thin wood lintels and sills. The attics are well lighted by a 6/6 sash peaked dormer window on the front of each house and by small, four pane sash in the gables. The front section has a moderate slope "A" frame roof resting on two string brick cornices on the front and rear and with double flue enclosed chimneys rising from each gable. The wing also has a moderate slope "A" frame roof, both being of metal, and a large chimney rises in the rear wall. The building rests on a rather low fieldstone foundation.
