DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

#21 is a 2-1/2 story brick attached house, three bays square with a two story brick "L" shaped wing, five bays long and two bays wide with a side balcony. All brickwork is in common bond. There is also a one story brick dependency. The front entranceway occupies the right (E) bay with double doors of panels and a segmental arched transom of two rows of headers with the center of the lower row recessed as on all front windows and on #23. All front windows are of 1/1 sash with segmentally arched shutters. Rear area windows are of 6/6 sash with wood lintels and sills, and there is a four panel door on the wing with a board and batten door on the dependency. The front section has a moderate slope "A" frame roof resting on two string brick cornices and a double flue chimney rises from the left side, possibly serving this house and #23. A small peaked dormer lights the attic from the rear slope. The wing has a shed roof and both are of metal. This house rests on a low fieldstone foundation and the front pavement is of her-ringbone patterned brickwork.
