DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

#105 is a three story brick detached house, three bays wide and four bays in depth with a two story brick "L" shaped wing, six bays in depth and two bays wide with a side balcony and newer concrete block extension. All brickwork is of common bond and the front has been restored, revealing a soft salmon shade. The main entranceway occupies the left (W) bay with a newer paneled door, paneled enframement, rectangular transom and white marble sill. This is enclosed by plain Doric pilasters headed by a flat entablature with a moulded cornice trimmed with dentils and moulded brackets. This is approached by a two step porch with wrought iron side railings. All front windows are of 2/1 sash with flat brick arches of shaped voussoirs in a darker shade of brick, are protected by louvered shutters and become shorter as they rise. Rear area windows are of 6/6 sash with wood lintels and sills. The front section roof slopes to the rear and the wing has a metal shed roof. The front roofline is decorated by a Victorian cornice with bands of incised crosses, scallops, geometric floral designs, and pointed dentils. The frieze contains an attractive band of incised crosses. Long narrow moulded brackets accent the bays. This house sets on a low foundation. There is an attractive flower yard to the rear.
