DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This is a 2-1/2 story brick pair of houses detached on the right (N) side and they are four bays wide and approximately three bays in depth with two story brick "U" shaped wings one bay wide and two bays in depth with a one bay square rear extension and end balcony on #415. All brickwork is in common bond and #417 has recently been restored. Simple front entrances occupy to outer bays and #415 retains a four panel door. An enclosed passage to the rear is centered between the houses. All house windows are now of 1/1 sash with wood lintels and sills, those on the front having moulded top lintels and #415 having louvered shutters on the front. The attic of #415 is lighted by a 1/1 sash window in the right gable. The front section has a moderate slope "A" frame roof resting on three string brick cornices and double flue enclosed chimneys rise from each end. The wings have shed roofs and all are of metal. The houses rest on a low fieldstone foundation.
