DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This is a row of four 2-1/2 story brick houses detached on the right (N) side and eight bays wide by two bays in depth. #421 has a two story brick "L" shaped wing one bay wide and two bays in depth with a rear balcony. #423 and 425 share a 1-1/2 story brick "T" shaped wing two bays square with #423 having been built up to two stories with remains of a rear balcony. #425 has a newer extension. #427 has a one story brick "L" shaped wing one bay wide and five bays in depth with a frame second story, side balcony, and one story one bay square frame extension. The balcony has an ornate Victorian cut banister section. All brickwork is in common bond and #425 and 427 have recently been restored. Simple front entrances occupy the right bay of each house. #421 and 423 have newer doors and boxed in overlights while #425 probably retains an original four panel door and four pane overlight with dentil trim. #427 has a newer door and a two pane overlight. Enclosed passageways to the rear are located between #421 and 423 and 425 and 427.

All front and rear windows are of 6/6 sash except #425 which retains old 4+4 sliding "lie on your stomach" casement sash windows in the upper section of the 1-1/2 story wing. All windows have wood lintels and sills with those on the front of #421, 423, and 425 having moulded tops and dentil trim as over the doorways. #427 has moulded top lintels only. The front section has a moderate slope "A" frame roof resting on two string brick cornices as does the 1-1/2 story wing of #425. This cornice is adorned on the front by the lower row of brick laid in the form of dentils as on its neighbors at 429-431. The wings have shed roofs and all are of metal. Double flue chimneys rise on the left of each house except #421 which is at the right gable. The building rests on a low fieldstone foundation.
