**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

#201 is a detached, 2-1/2 story frame house located on the intersection of an alley and is surrounded by lawn areas and an ornamental iron fence. It is three bays wide and two in depth with a 1-1/2 story frame "L" shaped wing approximately two bays square. The house is now sheathed with asbestos siding. A glass paned front door occupies the left (W) bay with a two pane overhead. The first floor is protected by an attractive covered porch with Doric columns and a dentil trimmed cornice. All house windows are of 2/2 sash excepting the top floor of the wing which has low 4+4 sliding casement "lie on your stomach" windows. The attic is well lighted by a large, front pediment enclosing a pointed top 2/2 sash window, and there are small, four pane windows in the side gables and in the rear gable. The front section has a rather steep "A" frame roof with enclosed double flue chimneys rising from each end and the wing has a moderate slope "A" frame roof, both being of metal. The front cornice and pediment are dentil trimmed. The house rests on a low fieldstone foundation and is fronted by a herringbone patterned brick pavement.
