**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

#107 is a 2-1/2 story brick house detached on the right (W) side, approximately three bays square with an "L" shaped wing approximately two bays square, a side balcony, and newer frame extensions. All brickwork is in common bond.

The simple front entrance occupies the right bay and both front and rear doors are of four panels with four pane overlights. All house windows are of 6/6 sash except on the first floor front, and all have wood sills and lintels as above the doors. The attic is lighted by two small, four pane windows in the left gable. The front section has a moderate slope, "A" frame roof resting on three string brick cornices and a wide enclosed chimney rises from the left side. The wing has a moderate-sloped shed roof. This house rests on a low fieldstone foundation and is fronted by a herringbone patterned brick pavement.
