DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This is a detached pair of 2-1/2 story brick houses, four bays wide and two in depth. #114 retains the original, low 1-1/2 story brick half of a "T" shaped wing, 1-1/2 bays wide and two bays in depth with an original brick, one story extension, short bays in depth, and a loft. The wing section walls of #116 have been altered, raised to two full stories, and extended by frame additions. All brickwork is in common bond.

The front entrances occupy the outer bays with #114 retaining a four panel door with top panels rounded as is the paneled enframing. #116 has a newer door with a regular paneled enframing and four pane overlight. The first floor front windows are of different designs--#114 has a double window of 1/1 sash, a moulded mullion, and is headed by a two string brick segmental arch in the form of a drip moulding with brick "Keystones" as above the door. This is protected by a wrought iron boxed grill.

The second story of #114 has 2/2 sash with wood sills and grooved lintels adorned by end blocks with carved roundels, as are the front windows and doorway of #116. First floor windows in the original wing of #114 are of 6/6 sash with sliding, 4+4 sash casement "lie on your stomach" windows above. Rear windows of #116 are newer, but all have wood lintels and sills. The attics are lighted by small, four pane windows in each gable. The front section has a steep slope, metal "A" frame roof resting on three string brick cornices with unusual dropped sections on each end of the front. The original wing of #114 has a moderate slope "A" frame with a wide, unenclosed chimney at the rear, and wide enclosed chimneys rise at each gable. The building rests on a low fieldstone foundation and is fronted by a herringbone patterned brick pavement.
