DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This is a 2-1/2 story pair of attached frame houses faced with brick in common bond on the front. #119 is three bays wide, #121 is two bays wide, and both are approximately three bays in depth with two story "U" shaped frame wings three bays in depth, one wide and side balconies. They are covered by board and batting and asbestos siding on #119 and German siding on #121. Front entrances occupy the end bays with newer doors and a board and batten gate headed by ornate Victorian-cut grillwork fronts an enclosed passage in the center bay to the rear yards. The walls of this passage are plastered and white washed. First floor windows are now of wide 1/1 sash while those above retain 6/6 sash, as on the rear. All have wood sills and lintels with pedimented, moulded heads on the front. The attics are lighted by peaked dormer windows of 1/1 sash on the front slope, but that on #121 has been widened. The front section has a moderate slope, "A" frame metal roof with double flue chimneys rising at the center. The front roofline is enclosed by a boxed wooden cornice. These houses rest on a rather low fieldstone foundation and are fronted by herringbone patterned brick pavements.
