

Description of Property and Eligibility Determination: *(Use continuation sheet if necessary and attach map and photo)*

The Gideon Gnegy House located at 34 Meadow Lake Road, is a side gable, frame house with a brick, exterior gable-end chimney. The original siding has been replaced with aluminum siding and the porches have been enclosed. The Maryland Inventory of Historic Properties form indicated that the roof was originally a steeply pitched cross gable roof. The building's integrity has been compromised through major alterations that reduce its integrity (materials, design, workmanship). The property does not appear to be eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places.


