
The Hetz Farm located at 2153 Green Lantern Road, is a side gable, frame I-house constructed in the late 19th century. The wood sash, double-hung windows are in a two-over-two configuration. The exterior walls have been covered with brick-tex. Access to this property was denied to the investigator by the homeowner.

The building's integrity has been compromised through rear additions and alterations that reduce its integrity (materials, design, workmanship). Additionally, this house is a common vernacular style and lacks architectural distinction. The property does not appear to be eligible for listing in the National Register of Historic Places.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This frame farmhouse is situated in a hilly area off Green Lantern Road approximately 3/8 miles northwest of the intersection of Sam Crow Road. The house faces southeast. It is a two story, three bay by one bay gable roof structure with a two story, one bay by one bay ell extending from the center of the rear, northwest elevation. A single story shed addition runs off the northeast elevation of the ell. A porch, supported by plain square wooden posts extends across the facade. The house is entered centrally from the facade and at the shed addition.

A central brick chimney is located on the main block with an interior gable end brick chimney on the ell. Two over two sash windows light the house. The house rests on a stone foundation with a cellar entrance at the northeast elevation. Asphalt shingles cover the house. The roof is covered with corrugated metal.

Numerous outbuildings including a frame barn and a springhouse are located on the property.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE:

This house is an example of a common western Maryland type. Houses of this general configuration, a rectangular main block and rear kitchen wing, were constructed in Garrett County from the late nineteenth through the early twentieth centuries.

This was the second farmhouse to be constructed by the Hetz family and was built about the same time as the other, circa 1901.


