The Stone Arch Bridge (Small Structure #11099X0), US 40 over Meadow Run, Garrett County, lies within the boundary of the Tomlinson Inn Historic Site. Like the Inn, the Bridge probably was built in 1813 or 1818 as part of the National Road. It is an early 19th century stone arch culvert, which was a design frequently used by Maryland's western counties for bridge material. The bridge is a contributing resource to the Tomlinson Inn Site, and eligible as such for the National Register of Historic Places. At the same time this Bridge appears to be an eligible portion of the potential discontinuous National Road Historic District, since it represents an element of the first U.S. Government-funded highway project (Criterion A) and as an early example of stone construction (Criterion C).






NORTH SIDE OF STRUCTURE
