Name of Property: House, Lammert Farm

Location: 18576 National Pike, Frostburg, MD

The Lammert Farm House was located on Old Route 40, just four tenths of a mile west of the intersection of 40 and Beall School Road. The farmhouse was built with Italianate style elements. It had a side-gabled roof with a front cross-gable and two interior end chimneys, one on either end. The building was clad with replacement siding, while a wooden cornice and brackets remained. The building had one-over-one wood windows, and sat atop a stone foundation. The full-length front porch was supported by turned posts and decorated with a balustrade. Above the first floor in the cross-gable was an arched window.

The house was destroyed sometime before 1993. While a nomination form for the property was completed in 1974, the house was listed as being vacant already at that time.

| <p>The house, located on the Lammert Farm, stands on the southerly side of U.S. Route 40 about .4 mile east of Beall School Road in northeastern Garrett County. The house sets back from the road about two or three hundred feet on the side of a hill that slopes downward in a southerly direction.</p> <p>The house is a two and a half story frame structure in the Italiniate style. It has a gable roof (the roof line runs east/west) and clapboard siding of which most has been covered by another type of siding in recent years. The facade consists of three bays with a center door and a cross gable with a round arch window above the center bay. There are a cornice decorated with brackets and two internal end chimneys of brick, one on each end. The major windows are double-hung wooden sashes with one-over-one lights. A one story frame porch with four turned posts and a turned balustrade stretches across the facade at ground level.</p> | |


