**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

This frame farmhouse is situated in a hilly, semi-wooded area and faces east. It is a four bay by two bay, two story structure with a gable roof. A single story shed porch addition, entered from the south elevation, runs across the rear, west, of the house. A cinderblock porch addition runs across the north elevation. A facade porch, supported by four wooden chamfered posts with a jig-sawn balustrade runs the length of the house. Entrances are located on the first story facade (slightly to the south side) and two beneath the porch at either end of the structure.

The house has two interior brick end chimneys, one at the south end, the other at the north. One over one sash windows light the house and a large modern picture window is located at the north end of the first story facade. Two, four paned windows are located in each gable end of the attic. The house rests on a stone foundation. There is a full-story cellar at the facade created because the house is set into a bank. The house and roof are covered with asphalt shingles.

There is a bank barn, facing east, to the north of the house.


