DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Finzel School lies within the community of Finzel and is in the process of being altered for use as a residence.

It is a one-story, frame schoolhouse measuring one-bay across the facade, south elevation, and three-bays along the side elevations. It rests on a low stone foundation and has weatherboard siding with cornerboards and a beveled wooden watertable. The gable roof is covered with asphalt sheeting.

The facade is on the south gable end and has a central entrance covered by a projecting, one-bay wide, enclosed addition with a gable roof. The facade door has two panels surmounted by a one pane window. Decorative wooden swags are applied just under the window. An enclosed shed addition covered with german siding adjoins the entrance projection on the east side.

There is a 2/2 sash window on the west elevation of the entrance projection and six windows, three on each side elevation, that were originally 4/4 sash, but are presently being altered (window openings have been reduced.).

There is an exterior brick chimney on the east elevation.
