DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Old Brown Place is situated in open, hilly terrain, approximately 1,000 feet south of the Pennsylvania border.

The farm consists of a frame house, barn and three sheds. The farmhouse is a 2-story, 3 bay by 1 bay central entrance house and faces east. The house is set into a small hill with a full-story basement under the facade, E elevation, porch. It rests on a stone foundation, has german siding and has a gable roof covered with corrugated metal.

There are 2 exterior gable end brick chimneys.

All windows are 2/2 sash. There is a single pane window in the attic story of each gable end.

The facade porch rests on 5 wood posts, has a wooden floor and a corrugated metal clad shed roof supported by four wooden chamfered posts with a plain balustrade. The porch is approached at the south end by six wooden steps.

There is a one-story shed addition on the rear, W elevation of the house with an entrance on the S elevation.

There is a spring west of the house. A small frame barn and three sheds lie east of the house.
