DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Dr. Murray House is located in the small town of Finzel on the east side of Route 546, the main road through town.

It is a two-story frame dwelling measuring three-bays by three-bays. It has a standing seam metal pyramidal roof with three hipped dormers on the facade, (west elevation), the north and south elevations. There is a one-story gable roof addition at the north end of the rear, east elevation.

The main block of the house rests on a concrete block foundation and the addition on a stone foundation. The walls are covered with aluminum siding, original siding is not detectable. All windows are 2/2 sash with aluminum storm windows.

The facade has a central entrance and is covered by a one-story hipped-roof enclosed porch. There is a sliding glass door at the south end of the porch.

There is an entrance at the east end of the south elevation. The addition has a shed porch which opens to the south and covers a central entrance.

On the north elevation, there is a cellar entrance under the main block of the house.

An exterior cinderblock chimney is located on the south elevation.


