## DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This frame farmhouse is situated on the western slope of Big Savage Mountain and faces west. It is a three bay by two bay, two story structure with a gable roof. An ell extends from the rear, east elevation. Another addition, two stories high with a flat roof is located along the north elevation of the ell and the rear of the house. A single story shed addition extends from the north elevation of this addition. A porch, supported by wooden chamfered posts with jig-sawn balustrades covers the facade. A smaller, similar porch is located at the rear of the house on the flat roofed addition.

The house has one central brick chimney on the main block, one brick interior gable end chimney on the rear elevation of ell and a exterior glazed brick chimney on the north elevation between the shed and flat roofed additions. Two over two sash windows light the house with the exception of six over six windows on the addition. The house rests on a stone foundation. It is covered with german siding with corner-boards. The roof is covered with corrugated metal.

A large deep, banked, stone gable roof springhouse is located in the wooded area north of the farmhouse.


