The Michael Road House is a frame 2-story, 3 bay by 1 bay dwelling based on the ell-plan. The house rests on a stone foundation and is covered with asbestos shingles, which cover both german and weather-board siding. The gable roof is covered with asphalt.

The facade faces southeast and has a central four-paneled wooden door entrance. Windows on the facade and southwest elevation are six over six sash, and three over one sash on the northeast and the northwest elevation.

There is a shed porch located at the corner of the main block and the ell on the southwest elevation. An entrance into the ell is located under the porch.

An interior brick chimney is located where the ell joins the main block.

A small frame bank barn is located NW of the house.


