The side elevations measure one bay across and the T measures one bay by two bays. One-story, shed-roofed additions fill the sides of the T and a one-story, hipped-roof porch runs the length of the facade.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The David and Lillie Weir House is located on the Avilton-Lonaconing Road approximately 2½ miles W of Lonaconing. The house stands behind a modern house and commands a view of the Savage River State Forest to the North.

The house is a two-story, gable-roofed, T-plan dwelling measuring three bays across the facade. The facade points NE. The side elevations measure one bay across and the T measures one bay by two bays. One-story, shed-roofed additions fill the sides of the T and a one-story, hipped-roof porch runs the length of the facade.

The house rests on a poured concrete foundation. The stud-constructed walls are covered with pink brick-patterned asphalt siding over tongue-in-groove weatherboarding. The windows are all one over one sash with plain mitred surrounds.

The roof exhibits a central cross gable on the facade and is covered with asphalt shingles. There are two interior brick stove chimneys: one at the T gable end, and one on the main block, just NW of center. The porch roof is supported by four round columns.

To the SE and SW of the house are ten frame farm outbuildings, including a pump, coal house, barn, corncrib, windmill and several sheds. It is not known whether they are of the same vintage as the house.
