The house on the Albertus L. Beeman Farm is a frame, 1½ story, gable-roofed building on a poured concrete foundation. Its basic configuration is a 2 bay by 2 bay block with a northeast gable end facade. A porch extends across the facade and continues around to the northwest side. Six over six, and one over one sash windows light the building. Its gable roof has an uneven pitch and an interior brick stove chimney located on the northwest side of the ridgeline. The rafter ends are exposed. Red, brick patterned asphalt siding covers a layer of vertical board.

A frame, gable-roofed, bank barn on a concrete block foundation lies east of the house. Associated with it are a concrete block milkhouse and a recently constructed corn crib. North of the house is a frame, gable-roofed outbuilding on a dry laid, rubble stone foundation.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Albertus L. Beeman Farm is located on the south side of Swamp Road approximately 1.9 miles east of Westernport Road. The land in this area slopes down from the crest of Big Savage Mountain to the southeast. A dwelling, a barn, and several small outbuildings comprise the site.

The house is a frame, 1½ story, gable-roofed building on a poured concrete foundation. Its basic configuration is a 2 bay by 2 bay block with a northeast gable end facade. A porch extends across the facade and continues around to the northwest side. Six over six, and one over one sash windows light the building. Its gable roof has an uneven pitch and an interior brick stove chimney located on the northwest side of the ridgeline. The rafter ends are exposed. Red, brick patterned asphalt siding covers a layer of vertical board.


