DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This abandoned frame vertical plank constructed house is situated in a hilly, semi-wooded area on Fairview Road approximately 5.5 miles southeast of New Germany Road. The house faces southeast. It is a two story, four bay by two bay structure with a gable roof with a box cornice. Two symmetrically located entrances appear on the facade, one of which is blocked off. The remaining entrance has a four panel door with a transom. An additional entrance is located on the north end of the rear, northwest elevation.

Where not boarded up, two over two sash windows light the house. Plain flat boards frame the windows. The house rests on a whitewashed stone foundation. The original whitewashed weatherboard exterior has been covered with "brick" asphalt siding. Corrugated metal covers the roof.

The remains of the springhouse are located southeast of the house.


