The Mildred V. Tichinel House is a type commonly built in western Maryland from the late nineteenth through the early twentieth centuries. It is a frame, two story, gable-roofed dwelling with a rear wing that forms an ell plan. Its facade is three bays wide with a center door and an unfenestrated second floor, center bay. A hip-roofed porch with lattice screens at the foundation and four square columns extends across the full length of the facade. One over one sash windows light the building on all elevations.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Mildred V. Tichinel House is located on the southwest side of Walnut Bottom Road at its junction with Chestnut Grove Road in Bethel.

The house is a frame, two story, gable-roofed, ell-plan on a rubble stone foundation. Its facade (NE elevation) is three bays wide with a center door and an unfenestrated second floor, center bay. A hip-roofed porch with lattice screens at the foundation and four square columns as supports extends across the full length of the facade. One over one sash windows with plain board surrounds light the building on all elevations. A one story shed-roofed addition fills in the southeast side of the ell at the rear of the house. Tan brick-patterned asphalt siding covers the exterior walls. The roof, which is clad with asphalt roll roofing, has an interior, brick stove chimney located in the rear wing.

Several small, frame outbuildings and a privy are also located on the property.


