DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The David Fike House is located several yards behind and to the S of a modern brick dwelling, also owned by David Fike. The houses are surrounded by farmland.

The house is a two-story, gable-roofed, T-plan dwelling with a symmetrical 3-bay facade. The facade points NW. A small shed-roofed addition fills in the side of the T on the NE elevation, and a shed-roofed porch runs the length of the facade.

The house rests on a low stone foundation, and the walls are covered with green asbestos shingles. The windows have 3 over 1 sashes with plain board surrounds. The surrounds and cornerboards are painted white. The central facade door has a three-paned transom.

The roof is covered with standing seam metal. There are two chimneys: an interior brick chimney on the SE gable end of the T, and an exterior brick chimney on the NE gable end of the main block. The porch roof is covered with asphalt shingles and has a small cross gable in its center. The porch roof is supported by tapering square posts, and the porch has a half-height wall covered with green asbestos shingles.

The interior has a central staircase but is otherwise unknown. The house is used for hay storage.


