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DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This two-story vertical-plank house measures three bays wide by one bay deep. The north-facing structure includes a one-story kitchen flanked by shed additions. A porch covers the east side.

The facade's central door is flanked by a pair of joined 1/1 windows to either side. 1/1 windows light the other bays, except at the rear, where 2/2 windows are used. The entrance currently in use appears under the porch in the east gable end.

A central brick stove-flue chimney heats the house. Tarpaper covers the roof-German siding sheathes the walls. In some areas the siding has fallen off, exposing the plank walls. Other sections of siding have been covered with tarpaper or insul-brick. The house stands on a stone foundation.


