The Ronald B. Westmoreland House is situated a few feet from Old Morgantown Road, east of MD Route 53. The house is part of the settlement known as Selbysport, now a well-kept small neighborhood.

The house is a two-story, gable-roofed, ell-plan dwelling with the ell projecting from the facade (S elevation). The facade door is east of center of the elevation of the main block. A one-story, hipped-roof porch spans the south elevation of the ell and fills in the ell on the east and south elevations.

## DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Ronald B. Westmoreland House is situated a few feet from Old Morgantown Road, east of MD Rt. 53. The house is part of the settlement known as Selbysport, now a well-kept small neighborhood.

The house is a two-story, gable-roofed, ell-plan dwelling with the ell projecting from the facade (S elevation). The facade door is E of center on the S elevation of the main block. The main block measures three bays by one bay, and the ell measures one bay square.

The house rests on a stone foundation and is covered with German siding. The windows are one over one sash with simple cornices and plain board surrounds. In the attic storys of the S and E gable ends, a band of diagonally-laid German siding runs across the gable at cornice level. This is pierced by a one-pane, segmentally-arched window with a decorated angle pediment. Both gable ends have jigsaw bargeboards. The siding of the house is painted white, as are the bargeboards. All other trim, cornices and cornerboards are painted red.

The roof is hipped at the NW corner and is covered with standing seam metal. The house has one interior brick chimney set W of center in the main-block.

A one-story, hipped-roof porch spans the S elevation of the ell and fills in the ell on the E and S elevations. The porch roof is covered with standing seam metal and is supported by square columns. To the E of the facade door, a one-story extension has been built out under the porch. The S elevation of the extension has a narrow one over one sash window.

On the E elevation, a door has been set N of the first floor window. The door is sheltered by a half-hipped roof porch supported by three square posts.

To the NW of the house is a small gable-roofed building, one and 1/2 stories tall and measuring two bays by one bay. The building rests on a poured concrete foundation and is covered with white German siding. The windows are two over two sash on the first floor and one over one in the attic story, with simple cornices and plainboard surrounds. On the E elevation are two white-painted doors. All trim is painted red. The roof is covered with standing seam metal. There is a central brick stove chimney.


