Description of Property and Eligibility Determination: *(Use continuation sheet if necessary and attach map and photo)*

The Robert Savage house is a two story, 4-bay frame structure with stone foundation located at 6553 Friendsville Road about .8 miles south of Friendsville. According to the tax records, the structure was built in 1904. The MHIP survey form on file at MHT indicates that the structure had been so altered that it lacks architectural significance. Since the original survey, vinyl siding has been added to the exterior of the house and the second floor windows have been altered.

The property is not known to be associated with events that have made a significant contribution to the broad patterns of local, state or national history (criteria A). The property is not known to be associated with the lives of persons significant in the local, state, or national past (Criteria B). The property does not embody the distinctive characteristics of a type; period or method of construction represent the work of a master; or possess high artistic values (criteria C). Finally, the property is not likely to yield information important in local, state, or national prehistory or history (criteria D).


The Robert Savage house is not eligible for the National Register of Historic Places.


