DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The State Line United Methodist Church stands on the south side of U. S. Route 40 on the southwest corner of the intersection of Pig's Ear Road in northwestern Garrett County near the Pennsylvania Border. The ground around the church slopes in a southeasterly direction.

The building is a one and a half story, frame, rural Gothic style structure. The roof line runs north/south with the gable end facing Route 40. The exterior is covered with shingle siding and the roof of the structure is tin. A small projection extends out the south side. A cupola with a steep roof and enclosed with lattice work sets on the north end of the building above the facade.

The facade has only a lancet arch doorway with a panel door and an arch transom. The sides of the building have three Gothic arch windows along them. The main windows are double-hung, wooden sashes with two-over-two lights.

The foundation of the structure is of masonry block and may be of recent construction.

The general condition of the building is good.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Architecturally, the State Line Methodist Church represents a type of building that was commonly erected in rural America for religious purposes. The style is frequently referred to as "Gothic" from the feeling of verticality created by the arch windows, the gable end being used as the facade, and the cupola above the front.

Although the exact age of the structure is unknown, it appears to date from the turn of the twentieth century period. This approximate date is based upon the stylistic features of the external trim around the windows and doors.

The State Line United Methodist Church is now included in the Grantsville charge. Apparently the property was given for the use of the church, however, it is to be returned to the donor (?) when no longer used for religious purposes. According to the tax records, the property is included as a piece of the neighboring parcel to the west along Route 40.

The tax records indicate the neighboring property is owned by Stewart M. Moser of Confluence, Pa. (Book 224, p.567) The church is under the West Virginia Conference, Romney District.


