DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Frank Paugh Farm is located on a hillside above Harmon Road in the farming community of the Cove. The farm consists of a log house, log barn and several modern outbuildings.

The house is a two story, gable-roofed dwelling with an asymmetrical three bay facade. The facade points S and is covered by a one-story, shed-roofed porch. The gable ends measure one bay. A two story frame cross-gable addition covers the N elevation of the house. The addition measures four bays across the N elevation and two bays on the side elevations. An enclosed shed-roofed porch covers the first floor of the N elevation.

The house rests on a stone foundation and is covered with aluminum siding. Inside the enclosed porch on the N elevation, the original german siding is still visible. All windows are one over one sash, and all surrounds have been obscured by the aluminum siding. On the facade, the central and E bays on the first floor contain doors, while the W bay contains a window. On the N elevation is a central door.

The roof is covered with corrugated metal. The house has two interior chimneys: a small stove chimney just E of center on the main block, and a large stone chimney near the gable end of the addition. The house also has an exterior cinderblock chimney on the E elevation.

The interior of the house is unknown.

North of the house is a large double pen log bank barn with a forebay. The logs are single saddle-notched and rise two levels. The exterior of the barn is covered with vertical boards. The forebay, on the W elevation, has been filled in with cinderblock. To the S of the barn is a modern silo, and to the N is an older silo. N & W of the barn are modern farm buildings. The barn is used for cattle.

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STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The owners speculated that the house and barn were built circa 1868. The house has been much altered and has lost much of its original character; however, the barn retains some of its original appearance. The single saddle notching of the barn is typically used for farm buildings.




