DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The John J. Guard House is located on Old Morgantown Road, approximately .8 miles from Selbysport. The site is backed by cornfields.

The house is a two-story, gable-roofed, ell-plan dwelling measuring three bays across the facade. The facade points S. The side elevations measure one bay across, and the ell, which extends from the N elevation, measures two bays square. The ell is filled on the S and W elevations by two-story and one-story shed-roofed additions, and a one-story, shed-roofed porch runs the length of the facade.

The house rests on a low stone foundation and is covered with German siding which has since been covered with aluminum siding. In the E gable end, the attic story was originally covered with fishscale shingles and has a single-pane lancet window. All other windows are modern replacements.

The roof is covered with corrugated metal. There is one interior stove and chimney at the corner of the ell and the main block. On the E elevation is a one-story, hipped-roofed porch in the process of being enclosed. The facade porch is supported by square posts.

The interior of the house is unknown.


