## DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Harold Georg Farm is located on Pud Miller Road, east of US Route 219S. The farm, consisting of house and barn, is located on rising ground and is surrounded by fields.

The house is a two-story, gable-roofed dwelling with a three-bay, center-door facade. The facade points NE. The facade and rear elevations are covered by one-story, shed-roofed porches.

The house rests on a coursed stone foundation and is covered with red, brick-patterned asphalt siding. The windows are two over two sash and have simple cornices and plain board surrounds. The facade, first floor windows have one narrow pane at the top and one large square pane at the bottom. The facade door has one large pane of glass set into it.

The roof is covered with asphalt shingles. The house has one interior brick stove chimney at the SW elevation. The porch roofs are covered with corrugated metal and are supported by chamfered posts. The facade porch also has a balustrade of crossed boards. The rear porch has been enclosed on the NW end to form a small storage room.

Southeast of the house is a frame bank barn covered with vertical siding. The bank entrance faces SW.

Southwest of the house is the site of a log house which formerly stood on the property.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

This house is an example of a common western Maryland type. Houses of this general configuration, with a rectangular main block were constructed in Garrett County from the late nineteenth through the early twentieth centuries.

The site was owned for a time by one Dave Bittinger and was known locally as the "old Bogert place". The barn was constructed in 1907.


