## DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The W. Sines House is located on Collier Road, adjacent to US Route 219S. Part of an old road runs east of the house.

The house is a two-story, gable-roofed, ell-plan with a three bay facade. The facade faces south and the ell emerges from the north end of the east elevation. A one-story two-bay by three-bay shed addition is attached to the house's west elevation. A one-story, hipped-roofed porch runs the length of the facade and along the south elevation of the ell.

The house rests on a coursed cut stone foundation and the plank-constructed walls are covered with asbestos shingles. First floor windows contain 2/2, 1/1, and 3/1 with simple cornices and plain board surrounds. There are several types of second-floor windows: three over one sash, two over two sash, and two-pane casement. All second-floor windows have simple cornices and plain board surrounds. The facade door is offset to the west of center. It has a transom. The addition on the west elevation has a door, with transom, near where the addition joins the main block.

The roof is covered with standing seam metal. The roof of the one-story addition has a false front on its south elevation. The house has two stove chimneys: one exterior brick chimney on the east elevation of the ell, and one interior chimney in the center of the main block.

The porch roof is supported by turned posts. The interior of the house is unknown.

The main block has a second transomed entrance in the eastern bay of the north gable end.
