The single-family dwelling at 4136 Bear Creek Road in Friendsville, Garrett County, MD is not located in an historic district, nor is it considered individually eligible for listing on the National Register of Historic Places. The two-story, four-bay dwelling was built ca. 1900. It is a frame structure, set upon a raised stone foundation and covered with a gable roof with a central chimney. The dwelling is representative of the domestic building of the period and lacks the architectural distinctiveness necessary to qualify it for listing under Criterion C.

The property is not known to have any associations with persons or events significant to our past and is thus not eligible under Criteria A or B.


