<p style="font-size: x-small; margin-top: 0;">DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE</p> <p style="margin-top: 10px;">The Grantsville Library stands on Main Street, U.S. Route 40, at the intersection of Bank Street, northeast corner, in Grantsville, Garrett County.</p> <p style="margin-top: 10px;">The building is a 1920 two story brick structure that was originally erected for a bank. The street facade has four brick flat pilasters the height of the structure with stone capitals and a dentilled stone entablature with the name "First State Bank" carved into it. The pilasters divide the facade into three sections. The outer sections have one large arched window opening with stone arches and sills. Each window opening has double-hung wooden sashes with mult-pane fan lights above. The entranceway with a recessed door is in the center bay with a stone medallion with the words "Founded 1910" and "Rebuilt 1920" carved on it. The double-hung sash windows and the front door, panelled with an arch window, probably date from the late 1960s or early 1970s.</p> <p style="margin-top: 10px;">The interior of the building consists of three large rooms on the first floor, two for reading and stacks and one for an office. The bank vault still exists and is used for the storage of magazines.</p> <p style="margin-top: 10px;">The building appears to be structurally sound.</p>

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE			
<p>The Grantsville branch of the Ruth Enlow Library, also known as the Grantsville Library, was erected about 1920 for the First State Bank. The bank was merged with the Liberty Trust Company of Maryland in 1960. The building was acquired by the Board of Library Trustees of Garrett County in 1966 for use as a branch office.</p> <p>The building is important as representing Neo-classical commercial architecture of the early 1900s and for its preservation through an adaptive use.</p>


