<p>The two log houses at Penn Alps stands to the east of Grantsville along the Casselman River with present U.S. Route 40 to the south and old Route 40 to the north.</p> <p>Each house is a rectangular block log structure, one story high, with V notching, square corners, wide spaces between the logs, and verticle board carved gables. The structures are not reconstructions but are new buildings (early 1970s?) constructed of old materials.</p>

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE			
<p>The two log houses that stand on the Penn Alps property were recently constructed of materials taken from early-mid nineteenth century houses in the Maryland-Pennsylvania area. The buildings are used as classrooms for the craft courses that are held each year at Penn Alps under the auspices of the Highland Association, an organization dedicated to the preservation of the folk crafts of the Appalachian region.</p>




