DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This brick farmhouse is situated in a hilly-semi-wooded area off Route 495 approximately 2¼ miles northeast of Dunghill Road. The house faces north. It is a two-story, three bay by two bay hip roof structure with a gable roof dormer extending from the facade and rear, south, elevation roof. A porch, supported by square chamfered wooden posts runs across the facade and around the east elevation. A porch, supported by brick posts, extends along the rear elevation. The house is entered from the central facade entrance with transom, and from the rear.

An interior brick chimney is located at both the west and east elevations. 1/1 sash windows light the house. The windows have stone sills and window heads. The cellar is entered below the facade porch at ground level. The house rests on a concrete foundation. The roof of this brick house is covered with diamonds-shaped asphalt shingles.

A barn and numerous other frame outbuildings are located on the property.


