DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This hewn v-notched log cabin is situated in a hilly, semi-wooded area just west of the north branch off the Castleman River on Durst Road. The cabin faces west. It is a single story, two bay by one bay structure with a gable roof. A corrugated metal overhang extends across the facade covering the only bay, an entrance set to the north end. A second entrance is located to the rear, east, elevation.

Modern windows have been put into the gable ends and one on the south elevation. A 6/1 sash window appears on the north elevation. The house rests on wooden sills set on stone pilings. The original hewn logs and chinking are exposed. The gable ends are covered with asphalt shingles. The roof also has been covered with asphalt shingles. A small window, just two logs in height, adjoins the frame of the eastern entrance. The end windows were probably originally 6/3 (as at the Edward Barnard Homestead G-IV-C-043) .


