DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This vertical plank constructed house is situated among pine trees on New Germany Road approximately 1 1/4 miles south of Fosters Inn Road. The house faces south. It is a two story, four-bay by two-bay gable roof structure with a two-bay by one-bay ell.

A single story shed addition is located at the west elevation. A wooden porch, supported by chamfered posts and plain square balustrades covers the two facade entrances.

An interior brick gable end chimney is located to the east elevation of the main block with an exterior cinderblock chimney at the rear, north, elevation of the ell. 2/2 sash windows, framed with plain flat boards, light the house. Small windows appear in the gable ends of the main block. The house rests on a cut stone foundation. The cellar is entered at the west elevation. Asphalt "brick" shingles cover the exterior framed with cornerboards. Corrugated metal covers the roof.

A smokehouse, blacksmith shop, and another structure are located to the west of the house. A barn is located to the northwest.


