DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Two perpendicular three-bay sections compose the main body of this two-story stud-frame farmhouse. The east section has a north-south gable roof, while the west section is capped by a roof running east-west. A porch wraps around the east, north, and west sides of the structure.

6/6 and 2/2 windows light the building. The main entrance occupies the easternmost bay of the west section's north side. An interior brick chimney heats the west end of this section.

The land falls away to the west, exposing this side of the cellar. Corrugated sheet metal covers the roof, and German siding sheathes the walls. The foundation is covered with cement.

A frame bank barn, a modern concrete maple sugar camp, and several sheds appear on the farm.


