DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This frame farmhouse is situated in a hilly area approximately one mile northeast of Bishoff Hill directly on Bishoff Road. The house faces southeast. It is a two story, three bay by one bay structure with a single story high and one bay by one bay ell with a gable roof. A shed addition slopes off the north elevation of the ell. A porch, supported by wooden doric columns runs across the facade. The house can be entered from the facades central entrance or from the small porch to the rear of the house on the north elevation.

An exterior brick chimney extends from the rear, northwest elevation. An interior brick chimney is located between the main structure and the shed addition. The house is lit by one over one sash windows. The house rests on a stone foundation. Asbestos shingles cover the house with asphalt shingles on the roof.


