DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This frame cottage is situated among hemlocks in a hilly area just off Friendsville-Hoyes Rd. approximately 3/4 mile north of that road's intersection with Bishoff Road. The cottage faces west.

The cottage is a story-and-a-half, three-bay by one-bay structure with a gambrel roof. A small shed addition is located off the south elevation. A rustic log porch extends out from the central facade entrance, complete with log balustrades and with scalloping in the wooden roof overhang.

An exterior chimney running 3/4 of the way up the house is located on the north elevation. The cottage is lit by 6/6 sash windows. Two, two-paned dormer windows extend out of the second story facade. Flat boards frame the windows.

The cottage rests on a flat stone foundation. Vertical boards and battens cover the house. The gambrel roof is covered with tar paper.


