| <p>The Hoyes Methodist Church stands on the northern side of the Hoyes-Sang Run Road, east of Maryland Route 42, in northern Garrett County at the village of Hoyes.</p> <p>The Hoyes Methodist Church is a circa 1872 frame, single Gothic structure consisting of a nave and an entrance tower and pavilion. The nave has three long stained glass windows along the east and west sides. The entrance is narrower and lower in height than the nave and has Gothic shaped double door entrance with a stained glass transom. The tower has a louvered belfry with a shingled bell mansard roof with a steep pitch gable on each side. The basement appears to have been added within the past couple of decades. The entire exterior is covered with a non-original shingle type siding. The roofs of the nave and entrance pavilion have asphalt shingles.</p> | |

The Hoyes Methodist Church is a small wood frame building of a type commonly employed in Garrett County for religious purposes. A simple, rectangular nave is reached by a smaller 'west' entrance porch. Rising from above the entrance and up the nave wall is a square tower with louvred belfry and shingled roof topped with a cross. There is some decoration in the form of 'carved' trim on the tower.


