<p>The building and pump stand a few feet back from the road on the westerly side of U.S. Route 219 about 3.6 miles south of Aiken-Miller Road below Accident in central Garrett County. The building is located on a plot of land that is part of a tract consisting of about 138.19 acres.</p> <p>The building is a one story frame structure with a gable roof that extends about a foot and a half to two feet over the present front (east side) covering the gas pump. The walls are covered with narrow horizontal siding. A door with four panels, a window with double-hung wooden sashes with two-over-two lights, and an opening covered by a door made of horizontal boards open off the front.</p> <p>The gas pump is about six feet tall with a glass cylinder with a metal cap at the top and a metal cone shape base and a hose.</p>


