<p>The house stands on the westerly side of U.S. Route 219 south of Accident across from the intersection of Aiken-Miller Road in north central Garrett County.</p> <p>The house is a two and a half story, frame structure with a gable roof and an ell wing attached to the southerly end of the back, west side. The principal facade, east elevation, has five bays with a center door on the first floor and all windows on the second. A one story frame porch with four free-standing classical columns stretches the length of the front. The roof line is broken by two internal, brick chimneys. The exterior walls are covered with modern siding. The windows of the facade and most of those of the north and south sides are double-hung wooden sashes with one-over-one lights. The other large windows are double-hung wooden sashes with at least one sash with six lights. The front door has a large oval glass of the type used generally in the early twentieth century.</p>

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

This house is representative of a type of mid nineteenth century dwelling commonly found throughout northern Garrett County. The buildings are basically large rectangular blocks of frame construction with symmetrical facades and a center hall floor plan usually with two rooms along each side. An ell wing may jut from the back wall. Porches on the facade appear to have been common. Most of the structure show signs of vast alteration over the years. In this house, the facade windows, door, and porch date probably from the early twentieth century.

This house form, which is a basic plan found in the mid Atlantic area (Pennsylvania and upper Maryland), may have been brought to Garrett County in the nineteenth century through the Mennonite migration from the Lancaster County area in Pennsylvania.


