DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Nathan Glotfelty Farm is located off Rock Lodge Road, about a quarter mile N of Mosser Road. The farm consists of a house, barn and several outbuildings and is surrounded by fields.

The house is a two-story, gable-roofed, Ell-plan dwelling with a three-bay, center-door facade, pointing E. A one-story, shed-roofed porch covers the facade and an enclosed, one-story porch runs along the W elevation of the main block and the N elevation of the Ell.

The house rests on a poured concrete foundation and is covered with asbestos shingles. The windows are one over one sash with mitred surrounds. The roof is covered with asphalt shingles and has a box cornice which returns on the gable ends.

The house has two interior chimneys: a brick stove chimney placed S of center on the main block and a stone fireplace chimney at the gable end of the Ell. The porch roofs are covered with asphalt shingle and the facade porch displays turned posts with jigsaw brackets. The interior arrangement of the house is unknown.

To the S and SE of the house are several frame farm buildings, including storage sheds and a chickenhouse. N of the house are several other farm buildings and a gable-roofed, frame barn. The farm has no bank entrance; rather, the upper floor is reached by a ramp.


